COVID+ RESULT

Your child has received a positive PCR or RAT result

THE PARENT:

- Call the school on 62789888 or email admin@stmichaelsbass.wa.edu.au
- Upload a photo or screenshot of the positive test result

- Report a positive RAT result to WA Health

THE STUDENT:

- Must **isolate at home** for 7 days from the day the RAT or PCR was taken

End of Isolation:

- At the conclusion of the isolation period, **if all symptoms have cleared**, the student can return to school
- Mask wearing is not mandatory after the period of isolation, however it is welcomed by the school
- No further PCR or RAT required

HOUSEHOLD CLOSE CONTACT

A member of your household has tested POSITIVE to COVID-19

THE STUDENT:

- Does not need to isolate **IF** - they do not develop symptoms and return negative RAT/PCR each day for 7 days
- Take a **RAT or PCR** test immediately. If positive, follow steps for a **COVID+ Result**

THE STUDENT:

- Does not need to isolate and can attend school (if no symptoms)
- Take a RAT/PCR test each day for 7 days
- must register their daily negative RAT on the school website

Student Develops Symptoms

THE STUDENT:

- Take a **RAT/PCR test** ASAP
- If test is POSITIVE, follow process for a COVID+ Result
- If test is NEGATIVE commence isolation protocols and daily testing for 7 days. Keep student at home until they are well.

Student Does NOT Develop Symptoms

THE STUDENT:

- Does not need to isolate and can attend school,
- Take a RAT/PCR test each day for 7 days
- If test is NEGATIVE, student can continue to attend school,
- If test is POSITIVE, follow process for a COVID+ Result

Parents need to notify school of students' household close contact status via CEWA form
