We are seeking a dynamic and enthusiastic upper primary teacher to join our dedicated teaching staff in 2019. This is an opportunity to join a school where the focus is on working with every student to reach their full potential.

This is a part time (0.4 FTE) temporary position commencing 1 January 2019 until 31 December 2019.

St Michael's School is a single stream co-educational school with an enrolment of approximately 240 students from Kindergarten to Year 6. The school was established in 1914 by the sisters of Mercy. St Michael's is a multicultural community, consisting of children from many ethnic backgrounds. An integral part of the school is the St Joseph's Centre, which caters for students with varying levels of special needs. The school enjoys a close relationship with the parish and strong support from the parent community

Selection Criteria:

Applications are invited from enthusiastic and innovative educators with the following attributes:

- A willingness to be a part of a collaborative, dedicated and enthusiastic staff
- An understanding of and willingness to engage with an early childhood educational philosophy
- A sound understanding of the Western Australian Curriculum and current educational theories and practices
- A demonstrated excellence in classroom management and organisational skills which create supportive and safe environments
- An understanding of and the ability to differentiate the teaching and learning program to cater for a variety of student needs
- An understanding and belief in data-driven teaching and learning
- Initiative, flexibility, resourcefulness and a passion for education
- A capacity and enthusiasm to build positive and constructive relationships with students, colleagues, parents and the wider community
- Strong ICT skills and the ability to integrate technology in the teaching and learning program
- Be fully supportive of the Catholic ethos
- Strong communication skills
- Active membership of the Catholic Church, as evidenced by a Parish Priest reference;
- Demonstrated involvement in school and parish life, including participation in out-of-school activities.

Desirable expertise and experience:

- Knowledge of co-operative learning strategies is advantageous.

Qualification/s Required:
