ABSENCE CALLS / NOTES / EMAILS

Therefore, please do not be upset if you receive an SMS or phone call from the Office to clarify the absence. Please note also, a SIGNED NOTE also needs to be provided to the teacher on your child's return to school. The Department of Education Services has confirmed that whilst an SMS or phone message is NOT a substitute for a signed note when reporting absences, **an email meeting the following criteria** can be accepted:

- ◆ the **full name** of the student
- ◆ the **class / roll group** of the student
- ◆ the **reason** for the absence
- ◆ the **full name of the parent/guardian** at the end of the message (the 'from' email address is not sufficient).
